Overview of Job

Music teachers educate students about the fundamental concepts of music theory such as rhythm, melody, pitch, and tempo. They conduct exercises like vocalization, harmonizing, singing, and playing musical instruments. They may also lead rehearsals in preparation for the school's musical performances.

- Rehearsals: Help conduct rehearsals for school performances and prepare students for performances

- Observe and evaluate students' progress
- Assess students' abilities, strengths, and weaknesses
- Work with teachers, the principal, and parents
- Collaborate with other teachers to teach other subjects
- Instrument maintenance: Maintain instruments and equipment
- Lesson planning: Introduce the main elements of music throughout the curriculum

- The ability to use interpersonal skills, public speaking, and active listening to support students
- The ability to manage many responsibilities, both inside and outside the classroom
- The ability to remain calm and fair when working with children
