KINTSUGI

In Japan, there is an ancient art form called Kintsugi. It's the art of repairing broken pottery and mending the cracks, chips, and breaks with gold.

The philosophy behind it is to honor the breakage as part of the history of the object, rather than hiding the past. The cracks, chips, and breaks are literally filled with a gold and lacquer mix.

Instead of discarding the broken object, the past is highlighted and honored. What's incredible is that the value of the object actually goes UP after it is repaired.

I think this is an incredible way to approach not just pottery, but **GRIEF** and **LIFE**.
