



JUNE 22 - Day 1: Trust the Wave

Scripture: Proverbs 3:5-6

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.”

Big Idea: I can trust God to lead my life / Trust God to lead

Heart of the Lesson:

Surfers don't control the ocean; they trust the wave to carry them. In the same way, we don't have to control everything in life. God invites us to trust Him rather than rely on our own strength. When we surrender to Him, He faithfully leads us in the right direction.

JUNE 23 - Day 2: Stay on the Board

Scripture: Matthew 7:24-25

“Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock.”

Big Idea: God's Word keeps me steady / Stand on His Word

Heart of the Lesson:

A surfer needs a strong board to stand on. God's Word is like our surfboard; it gives us stability when life feels shaky. When we listen to it and live it out, we can stand strong no matter what comes our way.

JUNE 24 - Day 3: Wipeouts Happen

Scripture: 1 John 1:9

“But if we confess our sins to God, he can always be trusted to forgive us and take our sins away.”

Big Idea: God forgives and helps me get back up

Heart of the Lesson:

Even the best surfers fall. We all make mistakes and fall short. But God doesn't leave us there... He forgives us when we come to Him and gives us a fresh start. His grace helps us get back up and keep going.

JUNE 25 - Day 4: Surf Together

Scripture: Hebrews 10:24-25

“Some people have given up the habit of meeting for worship, but we must not do that. We should keep on encouraging each other, especially since you know that the day of the Lord's coming is getting closer.”

Big Idea: We need each other to follow God / Grow together

Heart of the Lesson:

Surfing is better and safer with others around. God created us to live in community and to encourage, support, and remind each other of His truth. When we stay connected, we grow stronger in our faith together.
