

GENERAL CARE

Maintenance recommendations vary according to the materials used on each piece. PARISII furniture is intended for indoor residential use unless otherwise specified. Avoid prolonged direct sunlight, use coasters and placemats on finished surfaces, and protect furniture from extreme changes in temperature and humidity, which may affect its appearance over time.

WOOD

Exposed wood surfaces may be solid wood or wood veneer over a high-grade engineered core. All are protected with a lacquer finish. Dust lightly with a soft, dry or slightly damp cloth, following the grain. Do not use furniture polish, oils, waxes, abrasive products or chemical cleaners; these may shorten the life of the finish or cause cracking, lifting or discoloration. Wipe moisture promptly and dry the surface.

GLASS

Clean clear glass with a standard glass cleaner and a soft, lint-free cloth. Never use scouring pads or abrasive cleaners. A mild pH-neutral soap in clean water may also be used. Blot stubborn marks with a soft cloth dampened with a diluted vinegar-and-water solution; do not saturate edges or adjacent finishes. Sanded or frosted glass is delicate and should not be used as the top-facing surface unless specifically designed for that purpose. Install glass with the polished side facing up and clean it with particular care.

NATURAL STONE

Natural stone varies in color, veining, texture and pattern; these distinctions are inherent and contribute to its character. Clean with a damp microfiber cloth. If needed, use a small amount of pH-neutral soap in clean water, then rinse and dry. Avoid acidic, abrasive or chemical cleaners, which may scratch or discolor the surface. Blot spills immediately rather than wiping them across the stone. Depending on the stone and use, periodic resealing may be required. After cleaning thoroughly, apply only a sealer appropriate for the specific stone and follow the manufacturer's instructions.

METALS

Clean metal surfaces with a soft, damp cloth, then rinse and dry to prevent water spots. If needed, use a small amount of pH-neutral soap in clean water. Do not use chemical or abrasive cleaners, as they may damage the sealer or finish and lead to oxidation or rust. Powder-coated finishes are durable but may chip if struck or handled improperly. Stainless steel may be cleaned in the same manner; a cleaner made specifically for stainless steel may be used for stubborn dirt or light surface rust, following its instructions.

FIBERGLASS

Clean pigmented fiberglass bases with a soft, damp cloth. For excess dirt, use a small amount of pH-neutral soap in clean water, applied with a soft cloth. Rinse and dry. Do not use abrasives or harsh chemicals.

FABRICS & UPHOLSTERY

Professional cleaning is recommended for all upholstered pieces, regardless of material. We also recommend professional protective treatment after installation, using a qualified provider and a product compatible with the selected textile. For independent care, follow the cleaning code and instructions supplied for the specific fabric, leather or performance material used on the piece. Test any approved treatment in an inconspicuous area first. Do not saturate upholstery or use unapproved household cleaners.

NATURAL WOVEN MATERIALS

Vacuum gently using a soft-brush attachment. Wipe with a soft, barely damp sponge or cloth, then allow the material to dry fully. Avoid saturation, harsh cleaners and vigorous rubbing.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Always follow any material-specific instructions supplied with your order. When in doubt, consult a professional cleaner before treating a surface. Damage caused by improper cleaning, environmental exposure or unsuitable products is not considered a manufacturing defect.
