## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### 1) LOCATION

Wildflowers Holiday Market is located at 42338 Fruit Ridge Line, St Thomas, ON, N5P 3S9. Conveniently located just West of Sunset Rd, and minutes from Port Stanley Village and beach.

### 2) HOURS

Wildflowers 2026 Holiday Market will be: Saturday, November 7 from 10am-3pm.

### 3) WEATHER

Wildflowers Holiday Market is a rain or shine event. If the vendor chooses not to attend due to rain, they will not receive a refund.

It is at the discretion of the Market Manager to close the market early, cancel the market, due to severe weather, including but not limited to high winds, driving rain and extreme amounts of snow. Only under the guidance of the Market Manager, are vendors allocated to leave early. This is simply a safety issue, so vendors are not driving away on site whilst customers are wandering.

In the event of a market closure all vendors must take down their stalls and pack up for the evening. No vendor will be allowed to stay behind due to liability of the Market.

### 4) APPLICATION

Vendors are encouraged to submit their application by July 1, 2026. This application form can be found on [wildflowers.farm/markets](http://wildflowers.farm/markets). Please note that not all applications will be approved due to similarity or availability.

### 5) VENDORS SPACE

Wildflowers Holiday Market will be entirely outdoors.

- Each vendor will have a 10x10 area and will need to provide a shade/tent, tables, and chairs as needed.
- There will be a limited number of spaces with hydro and will be allocated to those selling ready to eat meals, and is ultimately up to the discretion of the Market Manager.
- A market map will be provided upon completion of the approved market vendors.

### 6) ALLOCATION OF VENDORS

The Market Manager or his/her designate shall allocate vendor space as follows:

- The Market Management reserves the right to allocate spots based on a successful market mix, with that being said some preferences will be given.
- The final stall allocation will include an appropriate product mix, and will be at the discretion of the Market Manager.

### 7) REGISTRATION FEE + VENDOR FEE

All payments will be invoiced and payable by e-transfer or credit card.

Fees Include:

- a. The following fees apply based on your commitment and type of vendor.

Artisan: \$133 +HST

Meal Vendor \$177+HST

8) FEE SCHEDULE

a. Registration fee is due upon receipt of invoice, and payment is due September 1, 2026

9) VENDOR REQUIREMENTS

All vendors must comply with the following regulations to operate at Wildflowers Holiday Market. Non-compliance with these regulations may result in the vendor being required to leave the market and they may not be permitted to return.

- a. A vendor must be familiar with the Rules and Regulations of Wildflowers Holiday Market and must comply fully with them.
- b. Vendors will post their names, location, and products prominently in their stall.
- c. Vendors agree to make their stall and products as attractive and pleasing to the eye as they can. Market Management reserves the right to request a vendor’s display be changed.
- d. Vendors must agree to bring an adequate supply of their primary product that will allow them to operate for the full duration of market.
- e. Vendors will adhere to the highest standards of quality, service and business.
- f. Vendor set-up time is between 7:30-9:30am
- g. Subletting and sharing of stalls is not permitted.
- h. Vendors agree not to practice distress pricing.
- i. Vendors shall maintain their stalls in a neat, clean and orderly fashion.
- j. Vendors must keep own refuse in a suitable container at their stall and remove refuse when they leave.
- k. General garbage containers are for the use of customers only. Please sweep your stand before leaving.
- l. Smoking is not permitted in the building nor at any vendor’s stall, or anywhere on the market square.
- m. All vendors must comply with the requirements set by Canadian Food Inspection Agency and local Health Units (labeling produce by type, quantity and price, cooling, sanitation, etc.)
- n. Vendors are responsible to obtain all necessary licenses, permits, inspections and certificates for the sale of their product.
- o. Compliance with both Provincial and Federal Sales Tax Regulations is responsibility of individual vendor.

10) CANCELLATION POLICY

Due to high vendor demand, once contract and payments have been made, all monies are non-re-fundable and non-transferrable.

11) ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

These are the rules and regulations established for the Wildflowers Holiday Market in 2026. There may need to be modifications of these rules and regulations at any time.

The Market Manager shall manage any items of business not specifically covered by these rules, at their discretion.
