OUR MISSION

Half a Million Kids is a nonprofit organization dedicated to foster and trafficked children. Our mission is to place every child eligible for adoption into a safe, permanent, loving home through our results based 3-Phase Plan. We intend to return foster care back to its original purpose: a short-term safety net for kids awaiting reunification with their birth/legal families.

OUR VISION

Half A Million Kids was created to place every child eligible for adoption into a loving home thus eliminating the circumstance of being raised in foster care as a way of life. By doing so, social workers can transition to a proactive versus reactive role. More impactful, the roughly 380,000 foster children not eligible for adoption and caught in the system awaiting reunification with birth/legal families can have the best possible home environments and a chance for success at beating the odds through our plan to revolutionize the group home setting.

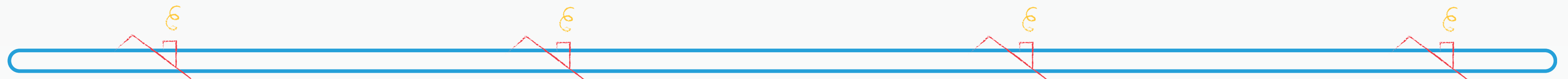

Completed Architecture of the revolutionary HMK Interactive SIIS Technology Solution

Organized Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regional team and National Lead of the Foster Youth Initiative (FYI) to tour the Being Beautiful Foundation House Parent Model that HMK is scaling.

We appreciate ongoing support from corporate donors such as Microsoft, M&T Charitable Foundation, WaWa Foundation and more. We are also grateful for a foundation grant from HCL Philanthropy to complete the planning and development of our micropilot region in Hunting Park-East Tioga area that will serve as the model for Philadelphia.

Invited and attended the signing of the *Fostering the Future for American Children and Families* Executive Order at the White House



Established and continued cultivating relationships with Corporations, Foundations and other Stakeholders vital to the funding & implementation of our Plan.

A Philadelphia Inquirer Investigative Report exposed the failures of the Philadelphia CUAs for child welfare. HMK jumped into gear to gain support of the Mayor and members of The Philadelphia City Council for our 3-Phase Plan.

Our Founder was invited to moderate a panel on Capitol Hill at the anti-trafficking summit in Washington, DC. Last year, HMK was one of the lone voices talking about prevention and bringing awareness to the intersection of foster and trafficked children at the summit... this year, there was an explosion of awareness and collaboration!

Completed Initial Architecture of HMK Whole Child Program titled **HomeBase™** to provide foster children the tools they need for life preparedness as they age out of foster care.

HALF A MILLION KIDS BLUEPRINT



The HMK Blueprint Sustainably Course Corrects the Foster Care System and Gets 45% of Foster Children in Safe, Loving Homes and Out of Harm's Way, Blunting One of the Major Pipelines for Child Sex Traffickers.

"The Key"

Through technology embedded with HMK Interactive SIIS, course correct and make sustainable the system itself which is critical to the success of "The Roadmap" and all other goals.

"The Roadmap"

This will get 45% of foster children in SAFE loving homes and out of harm's way which blunts one of the major pipelines for child sex traffickers. This will be achieved through our 3-Phase Plan Piloted in the Philadelphia region which represents $\frac{1}{3}$ of the foster children in Pennsylvania. Upon consistent upward trending outcomes, the program will be scaled nationally through an unprecedented Multi-Media Campaign to attract leaders to replicate the Pilot Model in their area as well as attract families to foster and adopt.

HMK was invited to and attended the signing of the *Fostering the Future for American Children and Families* Executive Order to modernize foster care. This important EO marks an unprecedented moment in child welfare reform, prioritizing these goals:

Expanding educational and workforce opportunities for foster youth.

Increasing access to scholarships, financial literacy and career pathways.

Strengthening placement stability and permanency, specifically for older youth, which connects to our Phase 3 that revolutionizes the group home setting.

Mobilizes public-private relationships, exactly like the ones HMK is building in our Pilot Region as well as at the state and federal level.

HMK was honored to moderate a panel on “Faith and Fighting Human Trafficking”

We also participated at a preliminary event at a White House Round Table, addressing urgent reforms needed to modernize foster care and strengthen protections against child exploitation.

HMK has also become a stakeholder at the White House Office of Public Liaison.

We were also honored with an appointment to the National Coalition to Combat Human Trafficking, further solidifying our role in shaping coordinated national strategies while continuing to bring awareness to the intersection of foster children and child sex trafficking.

REVOLUTIONIZING THE GROUP HOME SETTING AND HOMEBASE™ PROGRAM

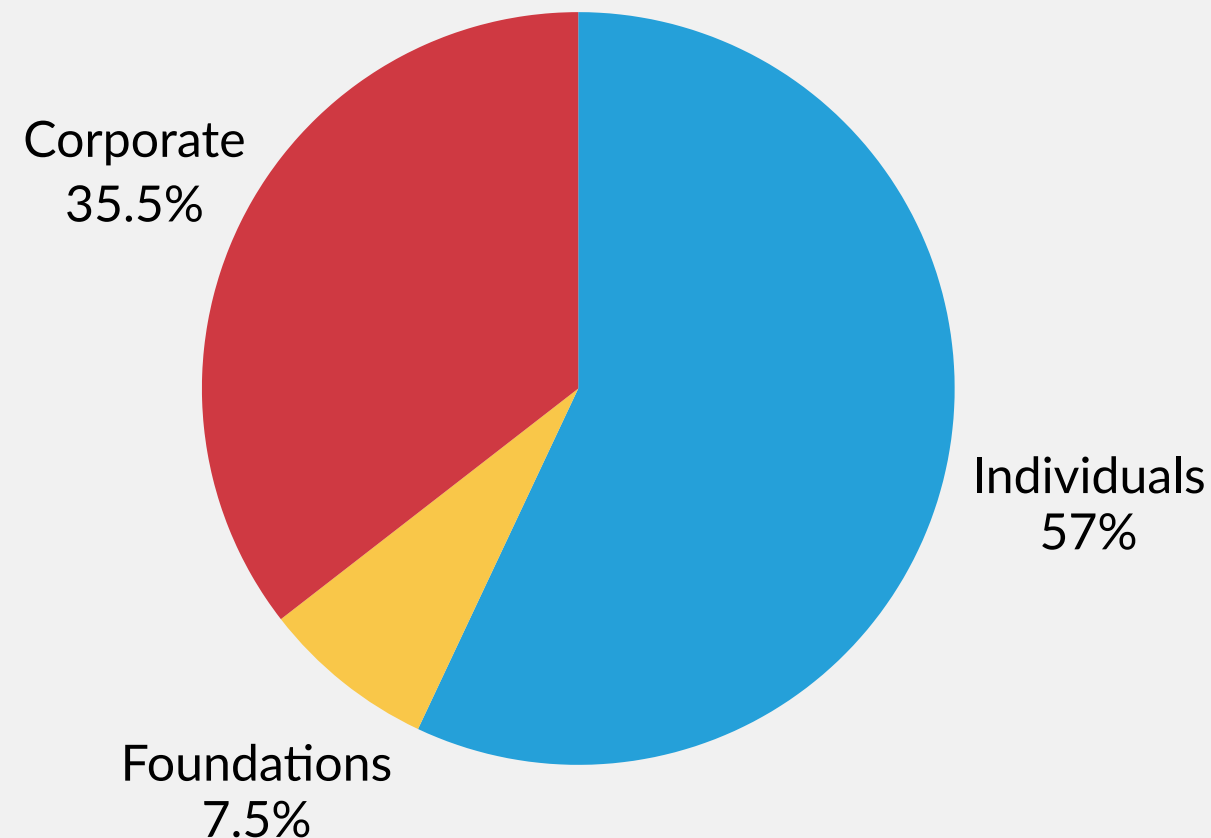
The Being Beautiful Foundation (BBF) has a Governor acknowledged, award-winning model that has 3 homes in Montgomery County, PA, having served more than 200 foster youth in a home that revolutionizes the group home setting by providing a family style home.

In 2025, HMK helped BBF advance as a leading foster youth house parent model, engaging county leaders, policymakers, HUD, HHS and philanthropic partners through immersive tours and their relational care model. Board vision sessions strengthened governance alignment and sustainability, while county partnerships supported placement stability and near-full capacity. Operationally, HMK worked with BBF to codify its model with budgets and created a comprehensive manual to guide quality, compliance, and replication in anticipation of partnerships with real estate investors, HUD and HHS's new program "A Home for Every Child". HMK and BBF are prepared to scale 20 new homes in the Pilot Region. These fast-moving efforts are accelerating progress and positioning BBF to influence residential foster care practices nationwide.

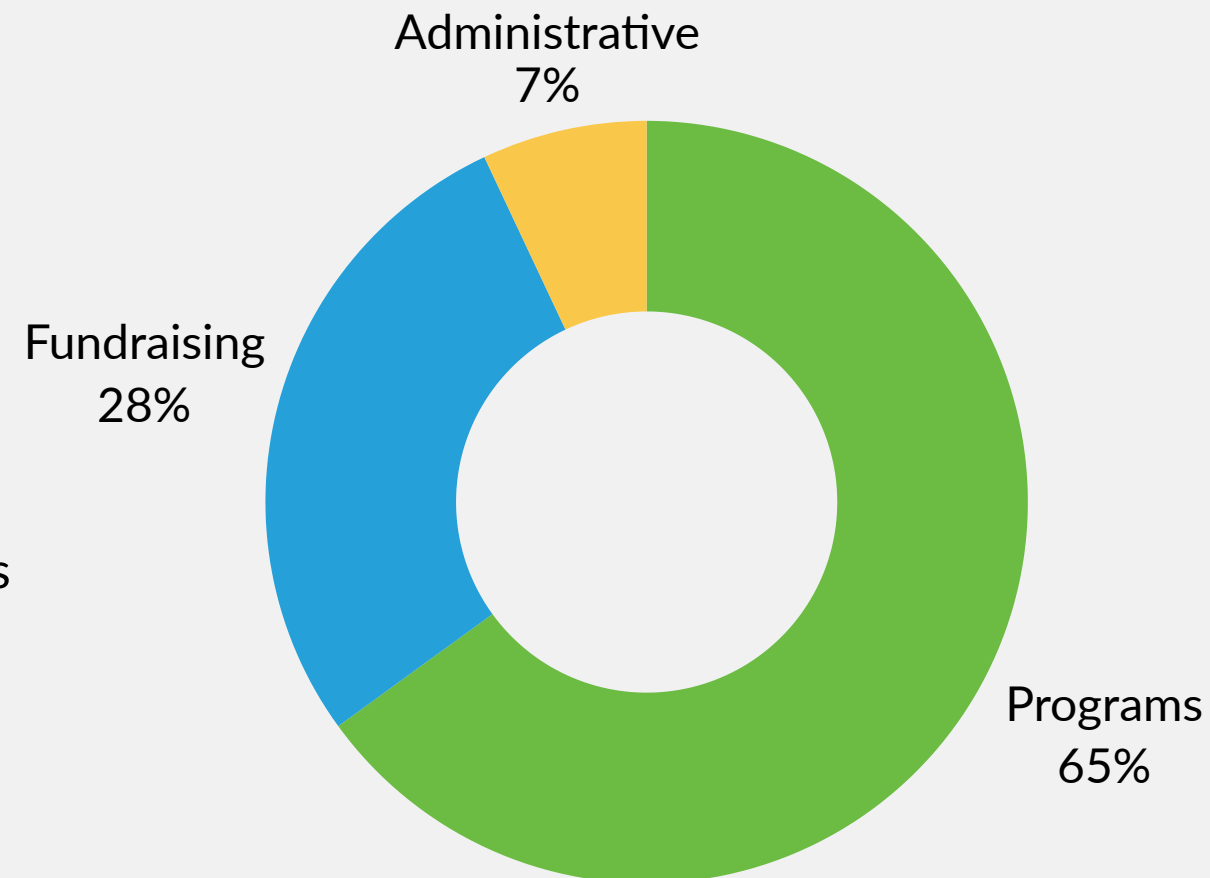
FINANCIAL SUMMARY & FUTURE FUNDING NEEDS



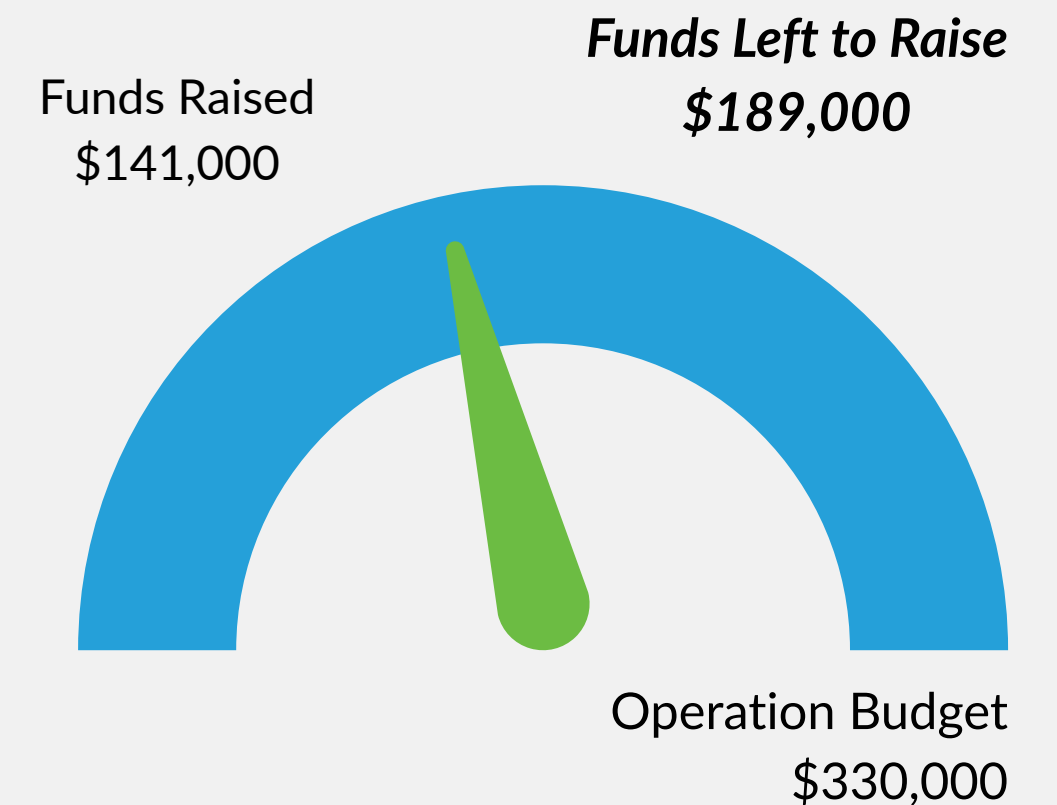
TOTAL REVENUE SOURCES

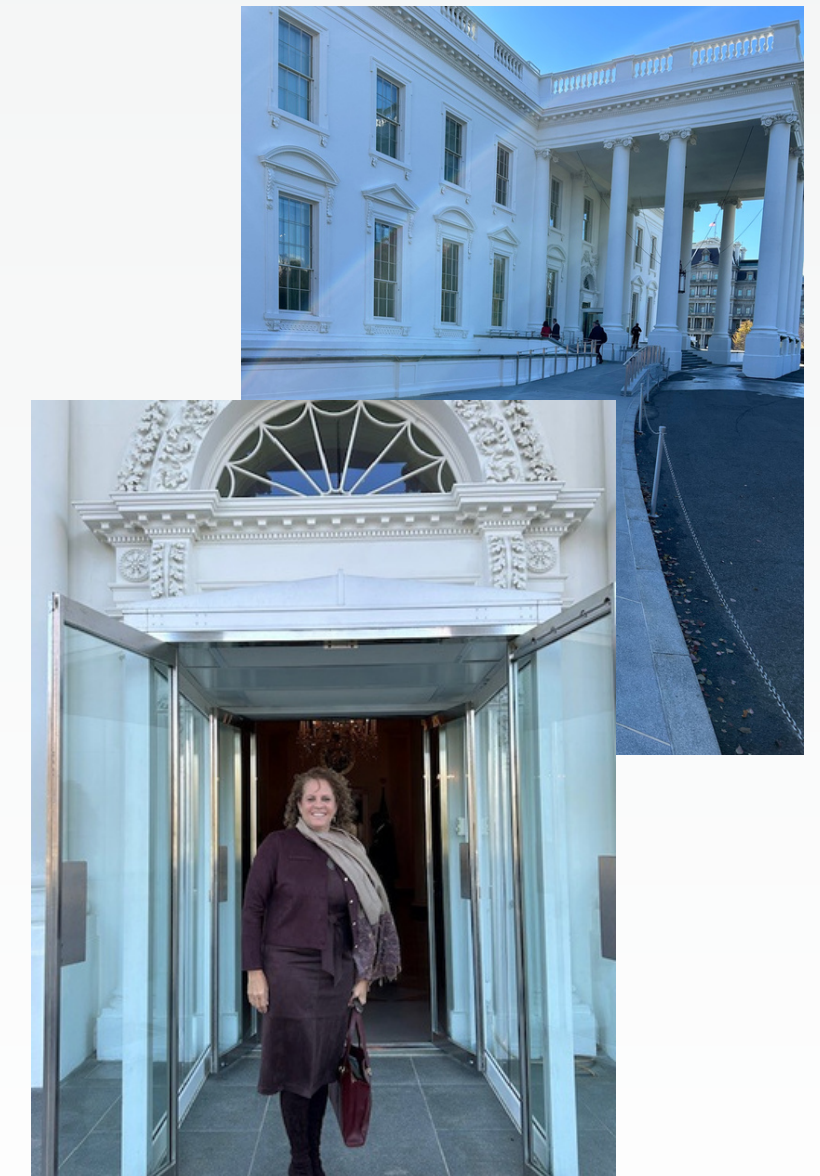
