Strand 1 – Faith in Focus: Scripture, Research and Innovation in the Church

This strand is for biblical scholars, researchers, theologians, practitioners, and church leaders to share their latest findings and insights. We welcome submissions that explore such things as contemporary church issues, congregational development, religious trends, scriptural and theological foundations, and the intersection of faith and society.

Driving question: What did you research?

Strand 2 – Theological Reflection

A strand for pastors, teachers, biblical scholars, theologians, practitioners, and students to share theological reflections on an important/significant biblical, doctrinal, historical, or ethical question to strengthen and help the Church's understanding and practice.

Text • 700–1000 words maximum • Use bullets • Avoid long paragraphs Font Size • Title - 80–100 pt • Headings - 32–40 pt • Body - 22–28 pt • Captions - 20 pt Images • High-resolution • Use charts instead of tables whenever possible. White Space • At least 30% of the poster should remain blank.	QR Codes – Presenters are encouraged to include a QR code that could link to: • full paper • handouts • ministry resources • videos • website • contact information Templates • Template will be shared with accepted posters • Places to print - Fed Ex & Office Depot
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
