Child & Family Nutrition

WIC — Women, Infants & Children

- For pregnant people, postpartum/breastfeeding parents, and children up to age 5

- Provides food benefits (milk, eggs, formula, fruits & vegetables), nutrition education, and breastfeeding support
- U.S. citizenship is NOT required
- Benefits accepted at participating grocery stores and farmers' markets

Free Summer & School Year Meals for Kids & Teens

- **AISD Free Summer Lunch Program** — free for anyone under 19
Text FOOD or COMIDA to 512-229-9110 to find meal sites near you • No registration required at many sites
- Caregiver meals also available at weekly curbside sites when accompanying a child
- Ask your school, community center, or clinic about free breakfast, lunch, and supper programs year-round

Affordable Grocery Stores

- H-E-B — strong low-cost full grocery option
- ALDI, Walmart, and Fiesta Mart — good budget grocery choices

Mobile Markets & Produce Access

- **Farmshare Austin Fresh for Less** — low-cost Texas-grown produce & shelf-stable items

- Farmers' markets and mobile markets may accept SNAP/EBT

SNAP / EBT & Savings Programs

- Most major grocery chains accept SNAP/EBT
- **Double Up Food Bucks** — matches SNAP dollars for fruits & vegetables at participating markets
- **Free SNAP enrollment help** — Foundation Communities, 5900 Airport Blvd, 78752 • Mon–Fri 9am–5pm
- **El Buen Samaritano also offers bilingual SNAP/Medicaid/WIC enrollment help** — (512) 439-8900
- If you may qualify, ask your provider about SNAP, WIC, and Summer Meals to stretch your budget
