2. Is there an area where you’ve been treating Jesus more like a helper than a Lord? What would it look like to surrender that area?
3. Which voice tends to influence you more—culture, your feelings, or Jesus? How can you better prioritize His voice?
4. Paul said everything was worthless compared to knowing Jesus (Philippians 3:7–8). What “things” are hardest for people today to put second to Jesus?
5. The rich young ruler walked away when following Jesus cost him something. Have you ever struggled to obey Jesus because it felt too costly? What happened?
6. What is one practical way you can re-center your daily life around Jesus this week?
7. What is one specific area where you sense Jesus asking you to obey Him right now?
