This position will be of interest to applicants with 1-5 years of experience.

Renfrew County offers pleasant small town living close to rivers, lakes and outdoor recreation. The Town of Renfrew is only one hour from Ottawa. This position requires you to work in-person at our Renfrew Office and when needed, travel throughout Renfrew County to serve clients and deliver public legal education sessions.

Duties will include providing legal advice, casework, public legal education, and community outreach.
