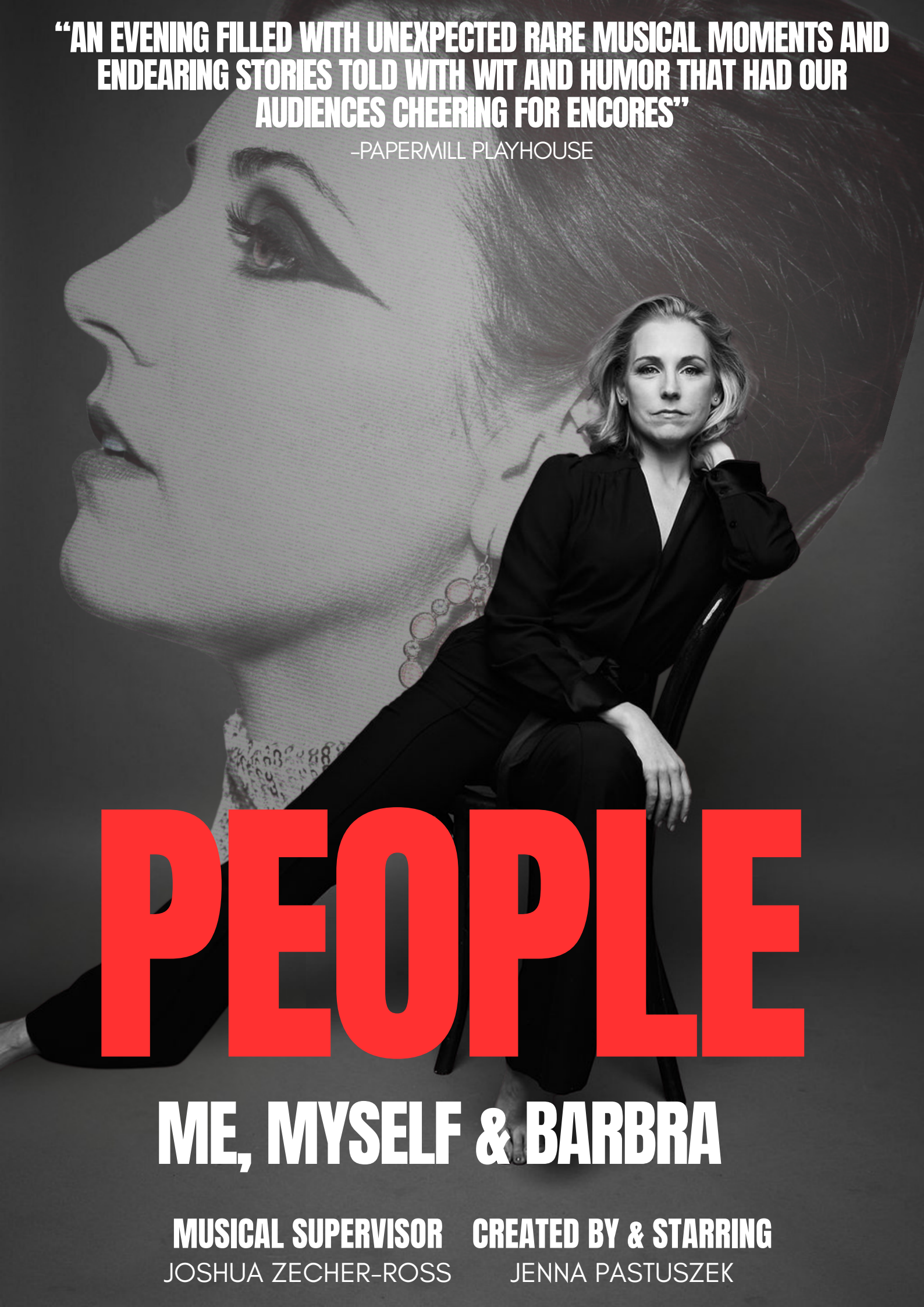

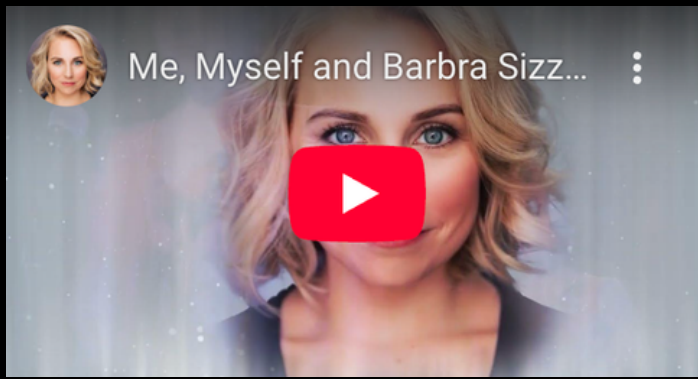

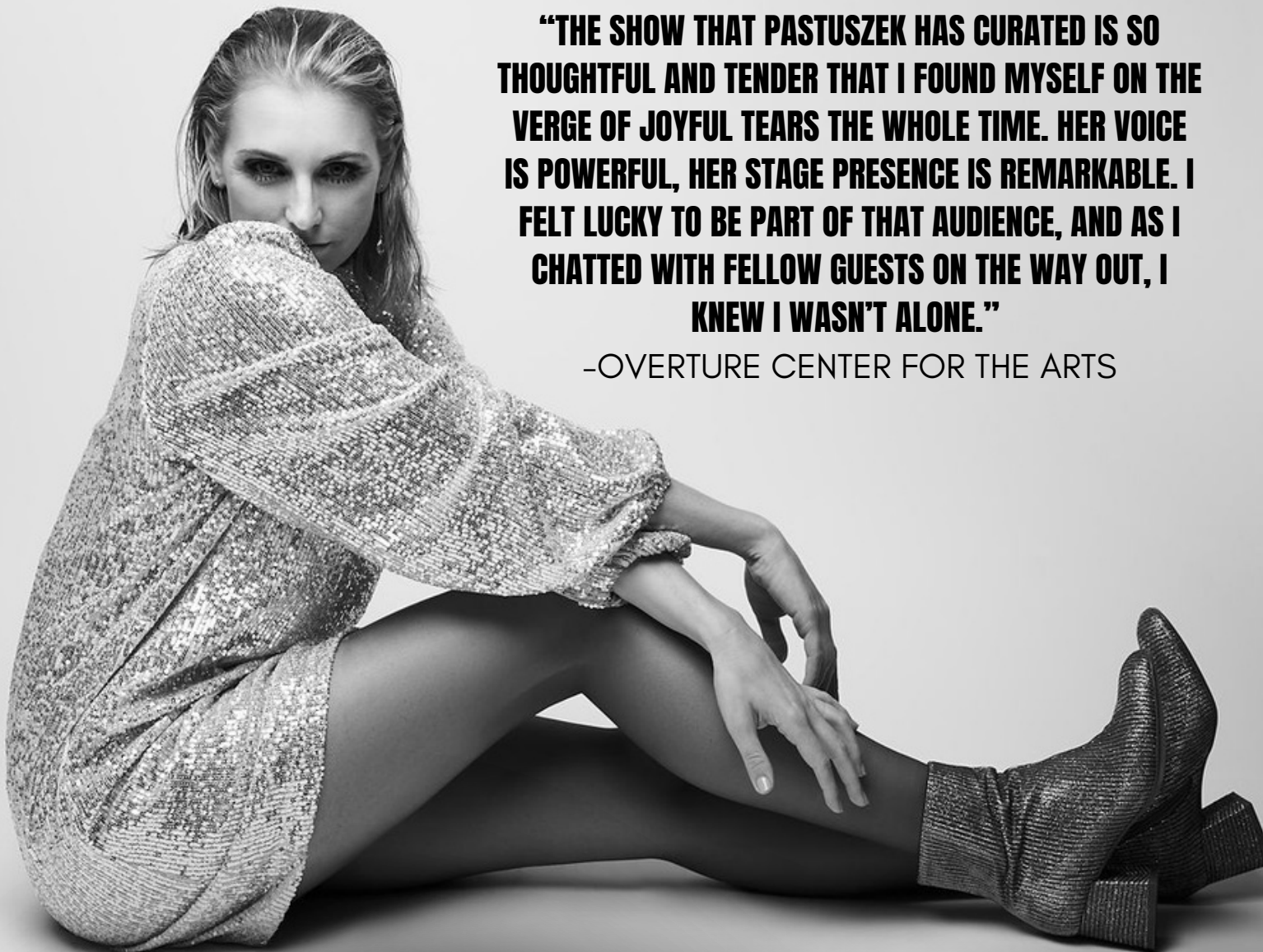

Regional credits include The Walnut Street Theatre, Delaware Theatre Company, The Eagle Theatre, The Media Theatre, Theatre SilCo, Gretna Playhouse, Sharon Playhouse, and more. She is the star, creator, and producer of two solo shows: GET HAPPY! An Evening Celebrating the World's Greatest Entertainer, Judy Garland, and ME, MYSELF & BARBRA. You can hear her on Pandora Radio as the voice of Starbucks Café, Amazon, Pepsi, Crest, and others. In addition to performing, Jenna is a highly sought-after voice teacher and performance coach, most recently at USC and UArts. She is the Co-Founder of Innovative Voice Studio, where she trains Broadway artists, and of Innovative Performance, where she coaches leaders across a variety of industries to use their voices to better express themselves.
