13. What is the biblical evidence that the Holy Spirit is God? (See Hebrews 9:14; 1 Corinthians 2:10-11; Genesis 1:2, Acts 5:3-4; Matthew 28:19)
14. Can people come to God or choose to believe in Jesus by their own power?*(See John 6:44; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Ephesians 2:1, 8-9)

15. Who gives us faith in Jesus, and how does he do it? (See 1 Corinthians 12:3 Romans 10:17; Titus 3:5-6; 2 Timothy 3:15)
16. Is speaking in tongues necessary to show that someone has the Holy Spirit? (See 1 Corinthians 12:7-11; Romans 8:9)
