SIGN UP FOR A LIFE GROUP



As a church, our heart is to help people grow in their relationship with God and build meaningful, life-giving connections with others. Life Groups are where those connections deepen. Life Groups are where real relationships are formed, faith is strengthened, and no one has to walk alone.

Life Groups are rooted in Jesus' call to make disciples. As we gather to learn, pray, and do life together, we grow in obedience to His Word and support one another in our walk with Christ. We believe God is present in these spaces, shaping us and reminding us that we are never alone as we follow Him (Matthew 28:19–20).

LIFE GROUP SERMON QUESTIONS

- *Read Matthew 22:36–37, Deuteronomy 6:4–5, John 15:10, and 1 John 4:19*
What does it mean to love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength? How is that different from simply having loving feelings toward God? 1 John 4:19 says, “We love because He first loved us.” How does receiving God’s love change the way we respond to Him? Can someone genuinely love God while consistently resisting what He asks them to do? Why or why not?

- *Read Matthew 22:38–40, John 13:34–35, and Philippians 2:3–4*
What does Jesus mean when He says, “Love one another as I have loved you”? What makes His love different from ordinary human love? What usually gets in the way of loving people the way Christ loved us? How can the way we treat difficult people reveal whether Christ’s love is truly shaping us?

- *Read Mark 10:28–38*
The disciples had already left homes, careers, and security to follow Jesus. What does their desire to be first reveal about the difference between outward sacrifice and inward surrender? What is the difference between wanting to be significant for Christ and wanting to be important in the eyes of others? How can leadership become an opportunity to love God and others?

- **Reflection:** If loving God and loving others are the two greatest commandments, what does the way you are presently living reveal about what you love most? Is there an area where you may be serving Christ outwardly but still holding something back inwardly?
