FAITH FOR THE UNSEEN

Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see. Hebrews 11:1 (NLT)

Faith for the unseen is learning to trust God's character before you ever see God's hand.

1. I trust God's CHARACTER more than my CIRCUMSTANCES.

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever. Hebrews 13:8 (NLT)

2. I remember what God has DONE when I can't see what He's DOING.

But then I recall all you have done, O Lord; I remember your wonderful deeds of long ago. They are constantly in my thoughts. I cannot stop thinking about your mighty works. Psalm 77:11-12 (NLT)

3. I choose trust before I have PROOF.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take. Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT)



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DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

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CONNECT

We opened this weekend's message by talking about trusting a pilot we've never met—what's something in your everyday life you trust without fully understanding how it works?

ENGAGE

What stood out to you the most from the message regarding having faith in something you're not able to see just yet?

GROW

1. The message says, "Faith for the unseen is trusting God's character before seeing His hand." What does that look like in real life for you right now?
2. Why do you think waiting seasons are often the hardest place to trust God?
3. What current circumstance in your life feels "loud" right now and is challenging your faith?
4. Which truth about God's character (faithful, present, good, healer, etc.) do you need to hold onto in that situation?
5. Share one specific moment where God came through for you. How does remembering that strengthen your faith today?
6. What would it look like for you this week to intentionally "rehearse" God's past faithfulness instead of focusing on what's missing?
7. The message said faith is a decision, not a feeling—where in your life do you need to choose trust before you have proof?
8. What fears or "what if" thoughts tend to pull you away from trusting God in those moments?

CHALLENGE:

What is one "unseen area" you're currently waiting on—and what is one practical way you can choose to trust God in that area this week?
