



Additional Fees 2026-27

Costumes

Costume(s) are required for your dancer to participate in our Spring Showcase. Costume orders are **NON REFUNDABLE** and are collected on **November 1st**. If for some reason your student is not planning on performing, you must notify us in writing prior to November 1st and you will not be charged a costume fee.

Epicenter for the Arts will assume that each registered student will be performing in the Spring Showcase unless otherwise notified. The following costume fee per class will be due November 1st. Triple Threat, Silks, & Acro classes do not have costume fees.

- \$95 (for Ages 3-6) per class, includes Tiny Combo, Epi Combo, Acro Jazz, and Pre Hop
- \$105 per class (See below for Ballet Costume fees)

Costume alteration expenses are the responsibility of Epicenter families.

Once costumes are approved by the teacher and parents sign the release form, they are considered final. If exchanges are requested at this point, upon Director's approval and if available, a \$15 shipping fee will be necessary.

If a student has paid for a costume and then drops the class, the family will have two weeks to pick up the costume, otherwise, we will consider the costume a return.

Ballet Costumes

Ballet Level 1 and up has a \$140 costume fee.

For your convenience, the Ballet costume fee will be divided into two payments:

- \$85 Non-refundable Costume Deposit, due by November 1st:
- \$55 Ballet Costume Balance due by February 1 (does not include boys)

If the remaining balance of a ballet costume is not paid by February 1, the student may not receive a costume, and the deposit will not be refunded.

If a ballet student **withdraws** from ballet class before the \$55 balance has been paid, they must pay the balance when they withdraw in order to receive the ballet costume. Otherwise they will forego the \$85 deposit for the ballet costume and will not receive a ballet costume.

Showcase Fees

For the **Christmas Show**, there will be a *non-refundable* \$35 fee for the 1st and 2nd student in a family, there is a \$70 family maximum, due **October 1st**. Please notify us before October 1st if your student will not be performing.

For the **Spring Showcase**: One program will be provided with each paid show fee. The *non-refundable* Show Fee will be posted to family accounts due by **March 1st**. If for some reason the dancer is not planning to participate in the Spring Showcase, you must notify us in writing prior to November 1st.

- \$45 for 1 student in a family -includes a video link to all shows & 1 program
- \$80 for 2 students in the same family -includes video link, 2 programs & 1 Bundle Ticket
- \$105 fee for 3 students in the same family -includes video link, 3 programs, 1 Bundle Ticket & 1 General Admission Ticket
- \$105 family maximum

Tickets will be available for purchase for the Spring Showcase.

Private Dance Lesson Fees

Private Lessons are scheduled by Epicenter for the Arts staff; please email info@epiarts.com to schedule private lessons and for more information on our scheduling process.

- Payment for the lesson is due 24 hours prior to the time the private lesson is scheduled and it is non-refundable.
- If the student needs to cancel, the office must be given a 24 hour notice. If the student cancels within 24 hours, no refund or credit will be given.
- If the teacher cancels within 24 hours, a credit will be given to the family's account and will also be given one free private lesson (of equal value).

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
