GENERAL TERMS

1. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
2. The City may withdraw any property from the sale before award.
3. The property is sold **AS IS, WHERE IS**, without warranty by the City except as expressly required by law.
4. Bidders are responsible for inspecting property before submitting a bid.
5. The successful bidder shall pay the entire purchase price within _____ business days after notification of award.
6. The City will not release property until payment has been received and all required paperwork has been completed.
7. The successful vehicle purchaser is responsible for all title, registration, tax, transportation and related costs.
8. The vehicle may not be removed until the City's title/transfer requirements have been completed.
9. No bidder shall receive preferential treatment because of current or former employment with the City.
10. Each bidder must provide sufficient identifying information for the City to contact the bidder and complete the sale.

FIREARM-SPECIFIC TERMS

The firearms listed in this solicitation are City-owned police duty firearms.

A firearm is being offered only as surplus municipal property and not as evidence, seized property or forfeited property.

A winning bidder for a firearm must comply with all applicable federal, state and local laws governing possession and transfer of the firearm.

The City requires the firearm transactions to be completed through a federally licensed firearms dealer (FFL) approved by the City.

The successful bidder shall be responsible for any applicable FFL transfer fee.

The City will not release a firearm until the required transfer process has been successfully completed. The FFL will determine what federal transfer documentation and background-check procedures are required. Where applicable, the FFL will require completion of ATF Form 4473 and conduct the required NICS process before transfer.

If the transfer cannot legally be completed, the City may cancel the award to that bidder for that firearm and may offer the firearm to the next highest responsive and responsible bidder or otherwise dispose of it in accordance with applicable law. The City makes no representation that any particular bidder is legally eligible to purchase, receive, possess or transport a firearm
