

Don't forget to stamp your Passport!

Riders participating in two or more disciplines – dressage, eventing, hunter/jumpers, gymkhanas, or hunter paces – are eligible for cash prizes at the end of the year! Each competition date earns two points and each year-end award you qualify for earns five points. Ties will be broken by points earned in the hunter pace category.

Passport books are available in the secretary's stand and need to be returned to the office by November 1st.

PeeWee/Leadline For children 8 and under and special needs of any age.

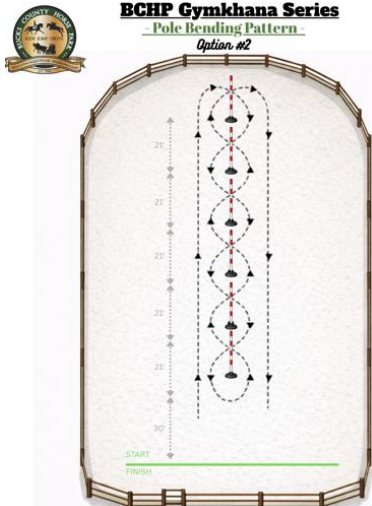
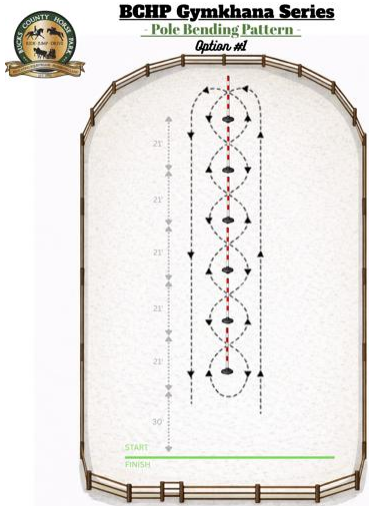
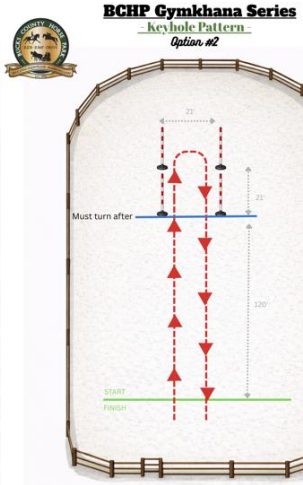
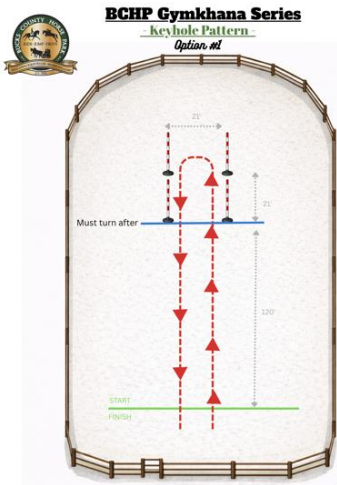
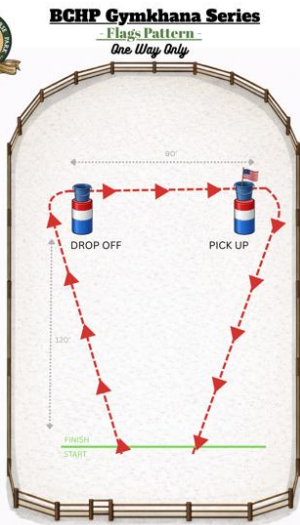
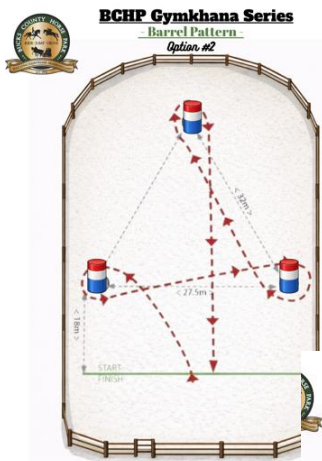
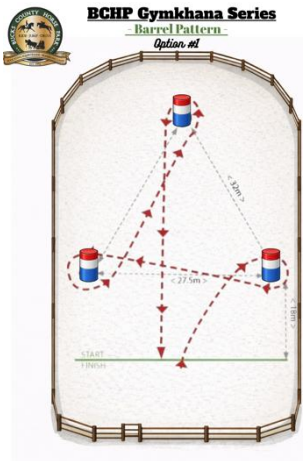

Entries accepted online via BCHP.HorseSpot.Net or in the show office beginning at 1:30 PM. Entries must be received by 9 AM the morning of the show to receive discount.

ATTIRE: Protective head gear is recommended for all riders when mounted and required for riders aged 17 and under. Sleeves, long pants, and Boots with heel required. Baseball caps are prohibited to be worn during a run.

AWARDS: Ribbons 1st through 5th awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve awarded to High Point Rider/Horse at each division with more than 3 riders. NOTE: Points are awarded using the scale of 10, 8, 6, 4, 2, with 1 point being rewarded for complete runs (excluding NT)


PAYOUT: Jackpot classes payout 50% of entries. Payout table will be based on entries received and posted at 5 PM.

DRAW: Draw will be posted at the office at 5PM prior to the start of competition

ELIGIBILITY: Age-restricted classes use the rider's age as of the first show of the series May 1 2026.

RULES: Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, cancel or change the order or location of any class. The show management's decisions are final. All exhibitors and spectators agree to comply with all rules stated here and in our rulebook. Failure to do so may result in disqualification, suspension, or permanent removal.
