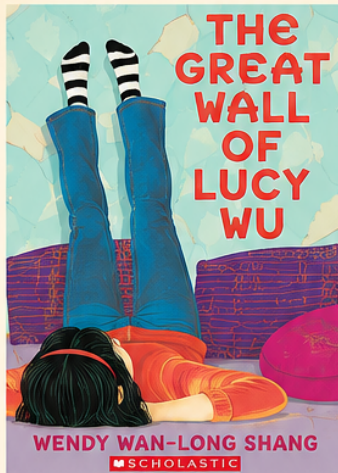

Lucy has to deal with new family rules, different traditions, and problems with friends.

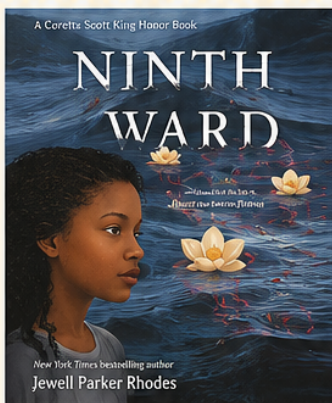
In the end, Lucy learns how to understand her family better and finds a new kind of balance.
