1. Care Packages

Campers love receiving mail and small surprises during their time at camp!

Food Policy

Please do not send food, candy, gum, or drinks in care packages.

Many campers have severe allergies, and outside food can create serious health risks. Food also attracts insects and wildlife around camp.

Campers may purchase snacks and treats from the camp store during the week.

Any food items sent to camp will be discarded.

Package Size Limit

Due to limited storage space, we can only accept packages that are:

- Medium USPS Flat Rate Box size or smaller
- Approximately 11" x 8.5" x 5.5"

All packages and large envelopes will be opened in the presence of a staff member when picked up from the camp office.

Through Bunk1, families can:

- Send Bunk Notes
- Receive photo tagging notifications
- Purchase photo downloads

Getting Started with Bunk1

1. Visit www.Bunk1.com
2. Create an account or log in
3. Use the Incarnation Camp invitation code: 2026IC
4. Choose the features or package that best fits your family. You can view photos without a paid account.

Returning Families

Returning users can sign in using their previous email and password.

Bunk Notes

A. Paper Forms (Complete by Hand & Upload)

Physician-Signed Medical Forms

Required medical forms must be completed and signed by your camper's physician.

You may upload clear photos or scans of completed forms.

Connecticut State Individual Care Plan

This form is required for campers who need additional care or accommodations during camp.

Please read the cover letter carefully. If you are unsure whether this applies to your camper, contact us and we will gladly help.

"Hey Camper" Card

This postcard is mailed directly to campers during the first week of May.

After your camper fills it out:

1. Take a photo of the completed card
2. Upload it to your CampBrain account

This information helps us with:

- Tent assignments
- Counselor placements
- Activity planning

B. Online Forms (Completed Through CampBrain)

Camper Information Form

Provides us with additional information about your camper.

Estimated completion time: 5-10 minutes.

Permissions & Waivers

Required permissions for camp activities.

Most families completed this during registration.

Medical Form

A detailed medical history and health information form.

Estimated completion time: 15–20 minutes.

C. Documents to Upload to CampBrain

Insurance Card (Front & Back)

Needed in case your camper:

- Requires medication
- Visits a doctor
- Needs emergency medical care

Immunization Records

These records may be obtained from your doctor's office and help our medical staff provide safe care.

"Hey Camper" Card

Please upload a completed photo of the card after your camper fills it out.

Final Reminders to get ready for Camp

- ✓ Review the family handbook
- ✓ Complete all CampBrain forms
- ✓ Upload all required documents
- ✓ Label your camper's belongings
- ✓ Reach out with questions before arrival!
