

## Dolphin Cruise

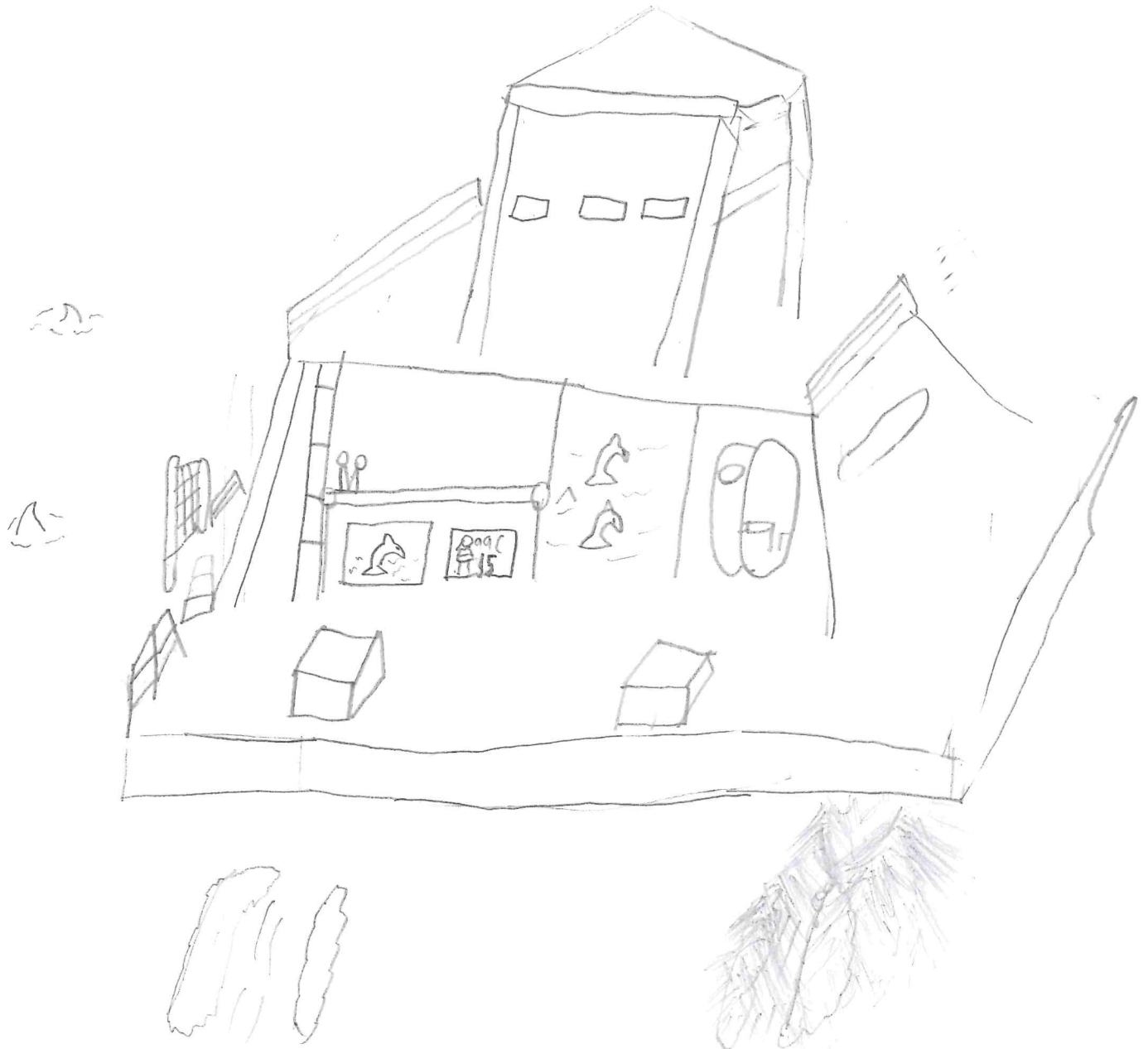

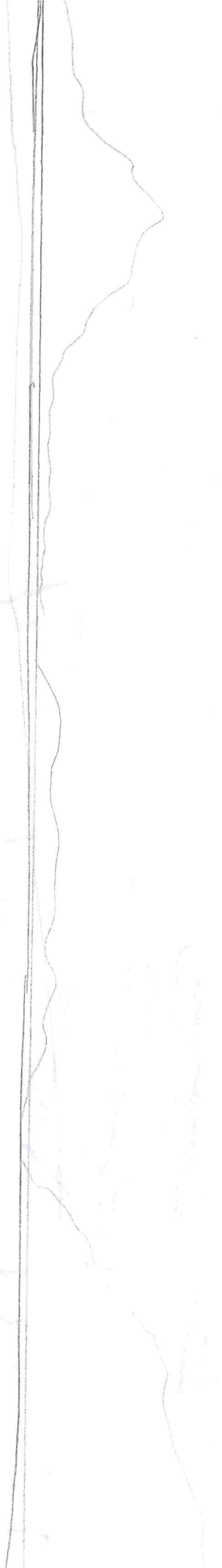
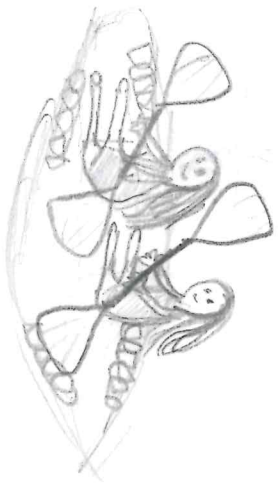
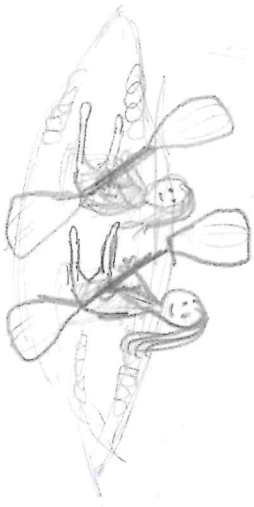
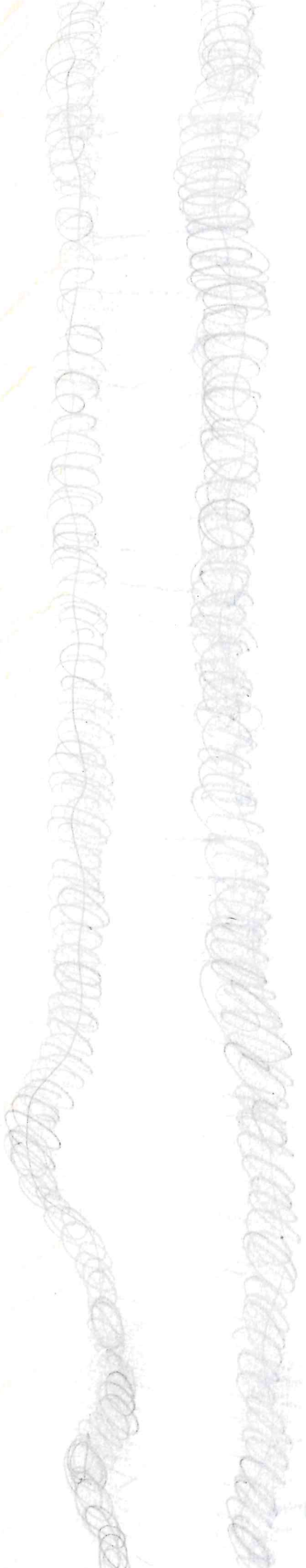


## Kayaking:

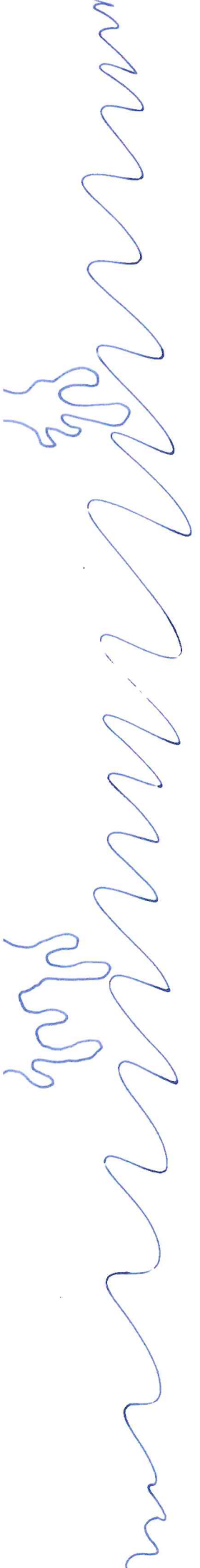


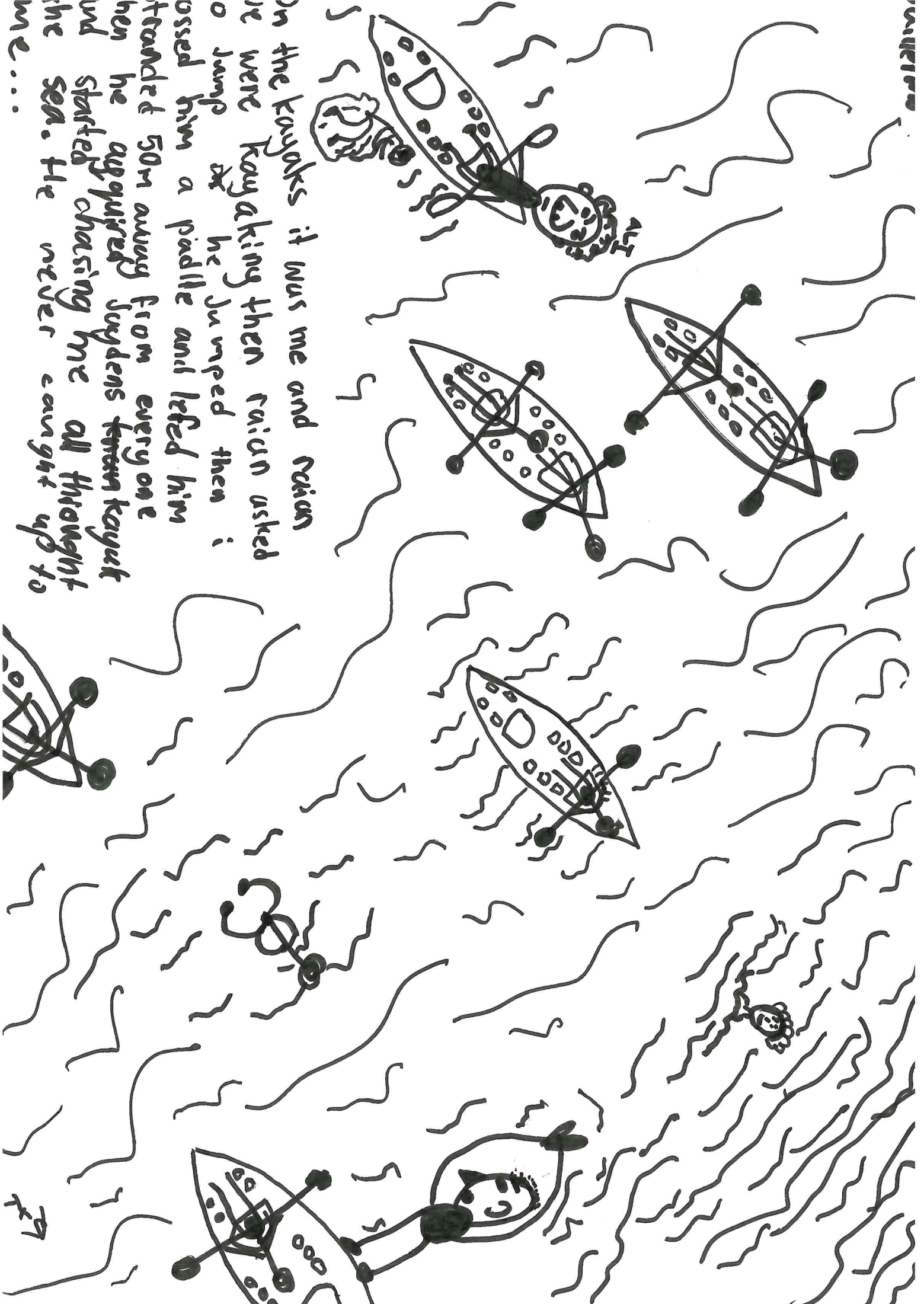
# Noah, Finn, Raian Kayaking

On another note, I Raian have been abandoned, lost in the middle of the ocean.

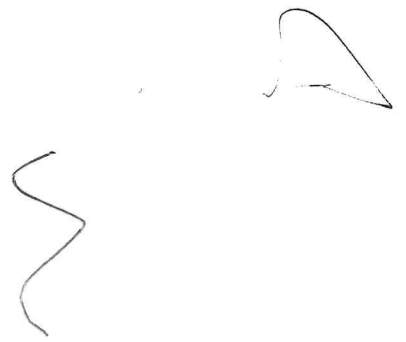
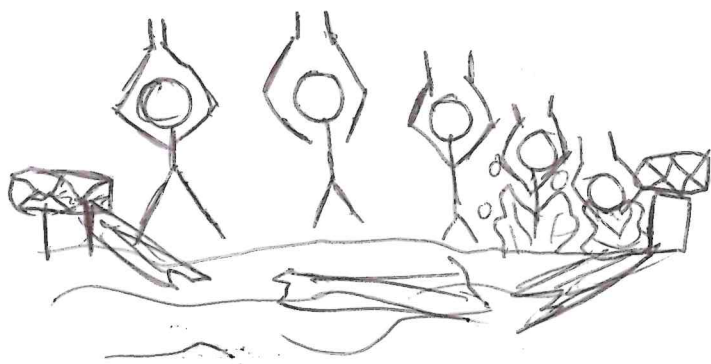

# Gully Crossing - Year 7 Camp

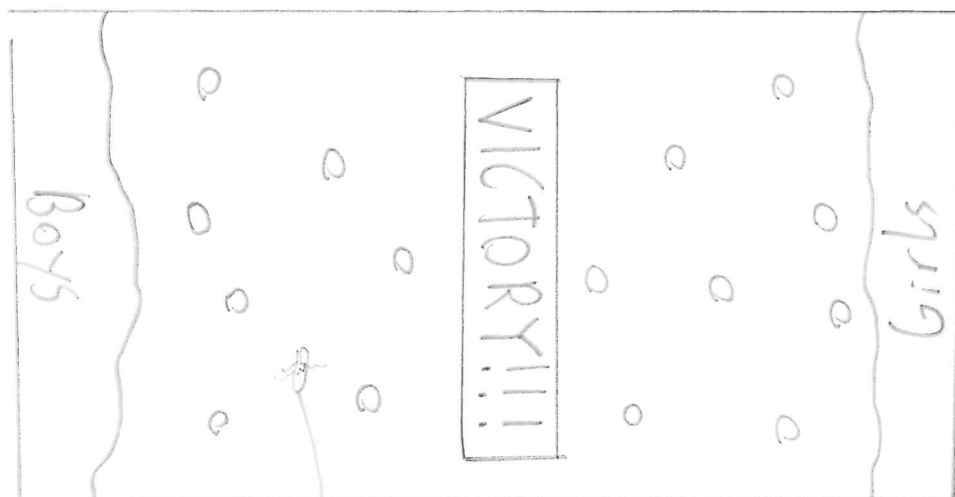
Eine von unseren Lieblingsaktivitäten war das Gully Crossing. Beim Gully Crossing gab es 2 Teams die gegeneinander antraten.
